2022 was a year of getting our programming back to normal and making significant investments in the future. I joined the team this past summer to build relationships and carry the vision of our chapter forward.



Over the past year, we invested in staff to bolster our school programming, elevate our marketing and branding, and ultimately to better steward our financial partners. Returning to our pre-COVID standard of programming was a great success for our chapter – a few highlights include:

- Sending six of our students to national leadership opportunities in California, Montana, Philadelphia, Michigan, New Jersey and the University of Notre Dame
- Impacting 435 participants through our on-site programming and 4,924 students through our school and community partnership programming
- Hosting 13 summer interns high school and college students who took on leadership roles and grew their skills through assisting with summer programming

We also started laying the groundwork for 2023. With a plan to re-engage schools post-pandemic, develop new partnerships and grow into more program sites, we look forward to achieving our goal of impacting more kids in at-risk communities. I hope you join us on what will be a fun adventure in the coming year. Please know our team is incredibly grateful for the support you have provided our chapter in 2022 – we

Our Impact

2022 saw First Tee – Central Ohio reach over 5,000 kids and teens with life skills, golf instruction and safe places to learn and grow. We offered 56 onsite classes at five locations in Columbus and the surrounding areas.

Our partnerships extended our reach to even more kids – with 13 schools and 11 community partners delivering First Tee programming throughout Central Ohio.

Participants ages 5-18 progress through the program over time, deepening their understanding of life skills and the game of golf. This integrated approach helps kids and teens build character for when they are on the course, at home and in school.

Every participant has the opportunity to:

- Learn the game of golf and how it relates to life
- Focus on interpersonal and self-management skills on and off the course
- Set up step-by-step goals and plan for the future
- Learn conflict resolution, appreciate diversity and build resilience



LPGA USGA Girls Golf

LPGA*USGA Girls Golf (Girls Golf) is an arm of our programming that specializes in creating experiences that show girls just how much fun golf really is!

Last year, our program served 123 girls at two program sites, helping them develop their skills and love for the game. In addition to regular classes, we also offered summer camp at Heritage Golf Club, which gave girls the valuable opportunity of spending time on the golf course.

We look forward to adding three additional programming sites and growing our community partnerships in 2023 – expanding our reach even further.



School Programs

School programming continues to be reinvigorated with the relaxing of COVID-19 protocols and bringing on our new School & Volunteer Engagement Manager, Jonathon Wilson.

2022 saw the creation of eight new school partnerships, thanks to generous funding from ScottsMiracle-Gro and the Memorial Tournament™ presented by workday®. These schools received First Tee equipment, refreshed curriculum lesson plans and training for teachers, and several will be further engaging with field trips to the golf course and First Tee participation at field days.

Teachers expressed excitement and appreciation for First Tee's partnership, and we are thrilled to bring our program to kids who might not otherwise have exposure to golf and life lessons that are learned through the game.

Community Programs

Our Community Program partners with other youth-serving organizations to introduce golf using games that are flexible to the ages and abilities of the kids involved. Throughout our summer season, we partnered with organizations like Buckeye Ranch, Home for Families and the Down Syndrome Association of Central Ohio to remove participation barriers and reach more kids, with a special focus on kids in underserved communities.

Through our Community Program, we provide training, equipment and lesson plans to youth development professionals and volunteer leaders to enable them to adapt our programming to any setting and skill level.

Participant Spotlight – Jake Pierce

During his father's deployment with the Air Force when he was seven, Jake Pierce was introduced to First Tee through a non-profit organization that connects service members' families with a variety of programs. Jake, now 18, remembers that even with no prior exposure to golf, he immediately loved the game, and has stuck with it ever since.



He plays on his high school's golf team, making it to Division 1 District competition, during this, his senior year.

This year, Jake also had the opportunity to play in the Hurricane Junior Golf Tour Tournament of Champions in Orlando, after qualifying for the event through a regional tournament.

Along with accomplishing some big goals in his golf life, Jake says his biggest takeaway from his many years in the First Tee program is the life skills. "I learned more about life skills – especially sportsmanship and integrity – than golf, which is awesome to me. It shows First Tee is balanced between the golf side and the life skills side."

Jake will graduate from high school in the spring of 2023 and is looking forward to playing college golf at Ohio Northern and potentially joining ROTC. He's thankful for all the years of support and opportunity he's had through First Tee. "I've met so many good people; been in so many great places," said Jake. "They really want to help you succeed in life."
